Originally from Buffalo, NY (go Bills!), Jackie graduated from Washington University in St. Louis with honors in 1997. She majored in Political Science and also studied French literature. After serving as a Fellow at *Panim el Panim* in Washington, DC, Jackie returned to St. Louis and graduated from Washington University School of Law in 2001. During college, Jackie was President of Student Union, Washington University's student government. She was also active in St. Louis Hillel where she co-founded Black Women/Jewish Women, a cross-cultural and interfaith dialogue group on campus and served as an intern. Jackie received the University's Ethan A.H. Shepley Award in recognition of leadership, scholarship and service to the Washington University community, as well as Hillel's Fred J. Rosenbaum Award of Excellence. Jackie is a licensed attorney in the States of Missouri and Illinois. She practiced in the business and securities litigation groups at Armstrong Teasdale in St. Louis for 8 years. In 2004, she was selected as one of St. Louis' *30 Under 30* by the St. Louis Business Journal.

Jackie has been an active member of the St. Louis Jewish community, co-founding the St. Louis Israel Connection (an Israel advocacy program for Jewish young professionals under the auspices of the St. Louis Jewish Community Relations Council) and serving as a Vice President of the Young Professionals Division of the Jewish Federation of St. Louis. She served on the St. Louis Hillel Board of Directors and co-chaired Hillel's 60th Anniversary Gala in 2007. She is a 2009 recipient of the Jewish Federation's Grosberg Young Leadership Award. Jackie is an active Washington University alumna – the former Chair of the University's St. Louis Young Alumni Association and former young alumni representative to the Alumni Board of Governors. She has served on Washington University's National Council for the Undergraduate Experience since 2007. She assumed her current position as President & CEO of St. Louis Hillel in October 2009.
